## Future Perfect Tense

**Future Perfect Tense - yeh use karte hain jab hum kisi future action ya situation ko us future point se bhi "pehle" wale perspective se dekhte hain.**

### **Future Perfect Tense**

**Yeh batata hai ki koi action future mein ek specific time se pehle complete ho chuka hoga .**

**Seedhe shabdon mein: "Future of the Future"  
(Bhavishya ka bhoot kaal)**

**Formula: Subject + will/shall + have + V<sub>3</sub> (Past Participle)**

1. **Do Future Actions (Ek specific time se pehle poora hona)**

**Jab hum kehna chahte hain ki future mein koi kaam kisi specific time tak khatam ho chuka hoga.**

**- Example:**

**- By next year, I will have completed my graduation.**

**- (Aane wale saal tak, mere graduation ki degree poori ho chuki hogi)**

- (Deadline se pehle hi project khatam ho chuka hoga)

## 2. Future mein kisi time se pehle ki duration batane ke liye

- **Example:**

- By 2025, she will have worked here for 10 years.

- (2025 tak usne yahan 10 saal kaam kar chuki hogi)

**Future Perfect ke saath commonly use hone wale words:**

- By (next year, tomorrow, 5 PM)
- By the time
- Before
- By then

### Trick yaad rakhein:

- Past Perfect = Past mein do actions, jo pehle hua

- Future Perfect = Future mein do time points, jo pehle khatam hoga

- **Past: I had eaten before he arrived. (Pehle khaana kha chuka tha)**
- **Future: I will have eaten before he arrives. (Pehle khaana kha chuka hounga)**
