## PRESENT PERFECT CONTINUOUS

**PRESENT PERFECT CONTINUOUS** ka use tab karte hain jab koi action ya situation:

### 1. Past mein Shuru Hua aur Abhi Tak Chal Raha Hai

Jo action past mein shuru hua aur abhi bhi continue ho raha hai

- I have been waiting for you for 2 hours. (Abhi bhi wait kar raha hoon)
- She has been working here since 2010. (Abhi bhi yahan kaam karti hai)

### 2. Recent Actions jo Abhi-abhi Khatam Hue

Jo action abhi-abhi khatam hua hai aur uska result visible hai

- I have been running . (Abhi khatam hua, paseene se bhara hua hoon)
- He has been crying . (Aankhen laal hain, abhi-ruka hua)

### 3. Time Duration Highlight karna

Jab action ki duration par focus hona

- They have been living in Delhi for 10 years.
- We have been studying since morning.

### 4. Temporary Situations

Jo action temporary hai aur abhi bhi chal raha hai

- I have been staying with my parents lately.
- He has been working on a special project these days.

### 5. Repeated Actions over Time

Jo action repeatedly ho raha hai over a period

- I have been going to the gym regularly.

**Present Perfect Continuous ke Common Time**

**Expressions:**

- For + period (for 2 hours, for 3 days)
- Since + point (since morning, since 2020)
- All day/week/month
- Lately, recently
- How long...?

**Formulas:**

- **Positive:** Subject + has/have + been + V<sub>1</sub> + ing
- I/We/You/They have been waiting .
- He/She/It has been working .
- **Negative:** Subject + has/have + not + been + V<sub>1</sub> + ing
- I have not been sleeping well.
- She has not been attending classes.
- **Question:** Has/Have + Subject + been + V<sub>1</sub> + ing?
- Have you been exercising ?
- How long has she been learning English?

**Has/Have ka Correct Use:**

- Has: He, She, It ke saath
- Have: I, We, You, They ke saath

**Important Rules:**

**For vs Since:**

- **For:** Period of time (for 2 hours, for 5 years)
- **Since:** Point of time (since Monday, since 2018)

**Stative Verbs usually is tense mein nahi aate:**

- ❌ I have been knowing him for years. (Incorrect)
- ✅ I have known him for years. (Correct)

**Present Perfect vs Present Perfect Continuous:**

**Present Perfect: Result par focus**

- I have painted the room. (Kamra paint ho chuka hai)

**Present Perfect Continuous: Activity/Duration par focus**

- I have been painting the room all day. (Din bhar yeh kaam chal raha tha)

**Examples:**

- "It has been raining since morning." ✓ (Abhi bhi ho raha hai)
- "You look tired. Have you been working hard?" ✓ (Recent action with visible effect)
- "How long have you been studying English?" ✓ (Duration focus)
- "She has been trying to call you all day." ✓ (Repeated action)
